Parish Council Elections

The term of office for the five members on the existing Patrick Brompton Parish Council expires on
Monday 6th May. This is also the date when the new Council will take office.

Elections to the new Council will be held on Thursday 2nd May. If more than five people put
themselves forward for election then Council membership will be decided by a vote of the Patrick
Brompton electorate; if five or fewer people put themselves forward then those candidates will be
elected without an election, unopposed.

If you want to be considered as a candidate in these elections you will need to get Nomination
Papers and other relevant forms from either The Returning Officer at Mercury House, Richmond or
by contacting the Parish Clerk – Jon MacNamara at charliehart.pb@gmail.com

These forms, and instructions for their completion, will be available from 20th March 2019 and will
need to be returned to the Returning Officer at Mercury House by no later than 4pm on Wednesday
3rd April.

You should also read the official Notice of Election displayed in the village bus shelter, or visit the
village website, for more information.

If there is to be an election, candidates will be able to circulate an election address to parishioners,
if they wish.
