Definition of an emergency

An emergency/major incident is an event or circumstance happening with or without warning that causes or threatens death or injury, disruption to the community, damage to property or to the environment on such a scale that the effect cannot be dealt with as part of the emergency services, local authorities and other organisations normal day-to-day activities.

Aim of the emergency response plan

To increase readiness, and responsiveness within the Patrick Brompton community before, during and after any major emergency in the village by establishing an organisation, management structure and procedures capable of reacting quickly and effectively at no notice.

Objectives

- 1. Decide what you can do and what you cannot do
- 2. Understand risks and vulnerabilities
- 3. Manage your expectations
- 4. Identify local resources
- 5. Know when you have to ask for assistance
- 6. Identify vulnerable people*
- 7. Check Holiday rentals
